

# HOW TO FIND 60 DUKE STREET

We are located near the centre of Liverpool

## BUSES:

Buses serving the south end of the city generally terminate at the new Paradise St Bus Station.



Most other buses stop at Queens Square Bus Station

Local rail travel stops at Central station (Wirral & Northern Lines) and Lime St, (City Line) which also takes Inter-City services.

Long-distance coaches terminate at Norton St Coach Station just north of Lime St station.

## FERRIES:

At present both Mersey and seagoing ferries use the same terminal north of Pier Head (others run to Birkenhead).

## BICYCLE:

We have secure cycle-parking facilities. Ask at Reception to have it unlocked for you.

## CAR:

If you are unfamiliar with the city, we suggest you follow signs for the Anglican Cathedral to get you to Duke St. There are parking meters on Duke St (cost £1 per half hour. 0800-1800 Mon-Sat) and a secure car-park (similar price) directly opposite.

## PARADISE STREET DEVELOPMENT

While this is being built there may be disruption to the normal movement patterns. At present (May 2007) there is no access through the area marked, and no vehicle access to Hanover St.
